

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 65 BY DECRIMINALIZING POSSESSION OF A GLASS CONTAINER AT A PUBLIC TOWN PARK IN BEASLEY, TEXAS, DURING EVENTS SPONSORED BY ORGANIZATIONS THAT COMPLY WITH CERTAIN SPECIFIED CONDITIONS; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEASLEY, TEXAS:


SECTION 2 of Ordinance No. 65 is hereby amended, effective on its passage, to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Except at any public town park in the City of Beasley, Texas, during its use at an event sponsored by an organization that:

- obtains the City's permission to use that facility for such an event,
- provides liability insurance coverage in minimum amounts specified by the City for its use of that facility during such an event and names the City as an additional insured under that insurance coverage, and
- provides at its own expense for security at such event,

it shall be unlawful for any person to possess a glass container on, in, or upon any public town park within the city limits of the City of Beasley, Texas."
