AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARY OF THE MARSHAL FOR THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR A CAR ALLOWANCE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the salary for the MARSHAL OF THE TOWN OF BEASLEY, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, shall be \$75.00 per month payable from the General Revenues of the Town of Beasley, Texas.

Section 2. That the TOWN MARSHAL shall be allowed an automobile allowance not to exceed \$25.00 per month for the actual expenses of the operation of the personal vehicle of said TOWN MARSHAL incurred in the discharge of said TOWN MARSHAL's official duties for the Town.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
